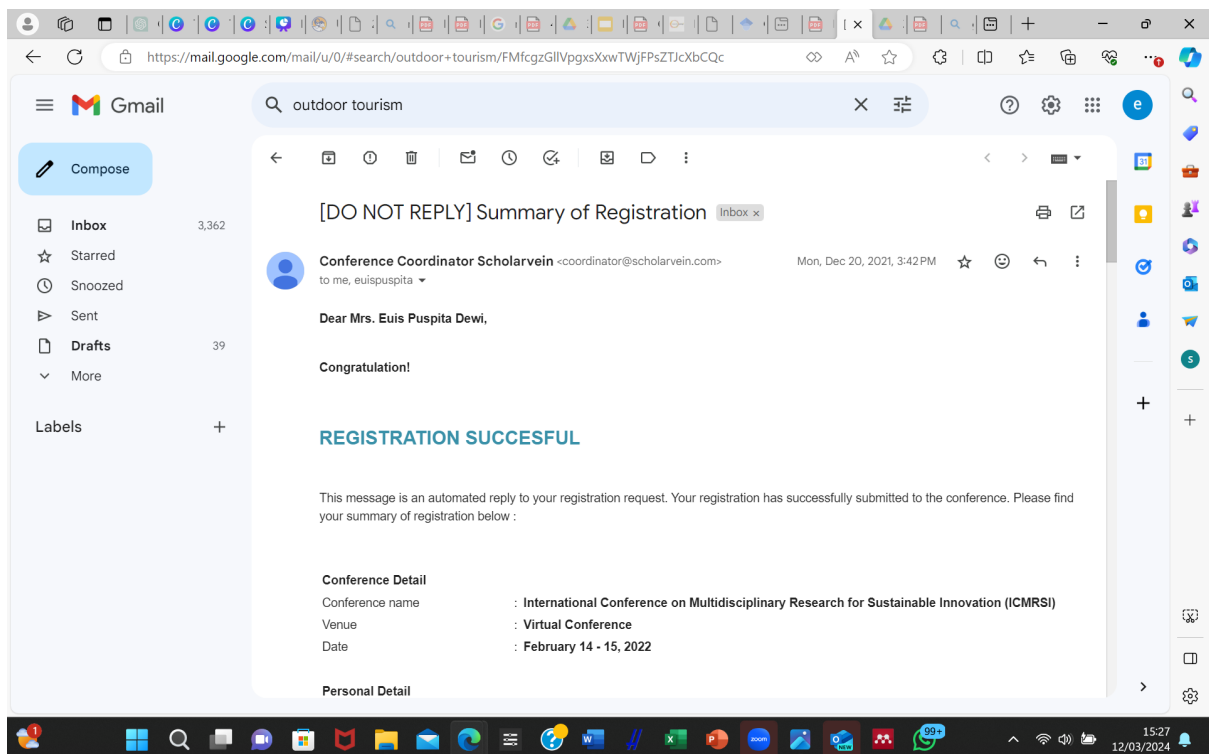
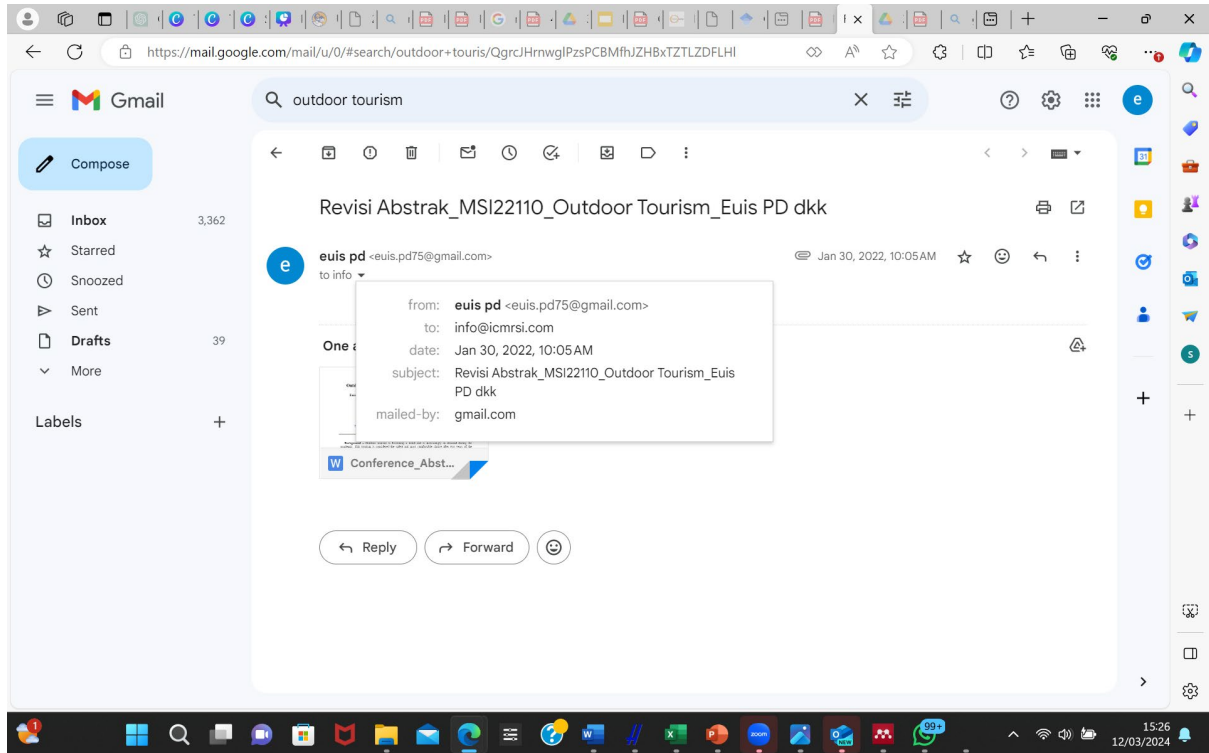

Findings - The result of this research is a shift in the tendency of public interest in tourism from the form of mass tourism to tourism that is private or small groups. Outdoor tourism that uses the concept of Community Based Development (CBT) is a solution in maintaining health and improving community welfare. Outdoor tour packages with various choices, ranging from nature-based tours, sports, therapy, adventures are offered in order to improve physical and mental health after the pandemic. The involvement of local communities can increase the level of the economy while creating sustainable tourism. Smart Tourism is a solution going forward in order to integrate all outdoor tourism facilities into One Stop Sentul Tourism.

Research Limitations - This research is limited through a case study on Sentul Outdoor Tourism as the object of research.
